MediaFinder Instruction manual

Welcome to the MediaFinder instruction manual. MediaFinder is an app developed by <u>011.software</u>.

MediaFinder is your personal catalog for tracking all your physical media — including music (CDs, vinyl, etc.), movies, TV shows (DVD, Blu-ray, etc.), books, and video games (all consoles).


Easily manage both the media you **own** and the items on your **wishlist**.

When you're out shopping or browsing, **Search Mode** gives you quick access to your full collection and wishlist, helping you avoid duplicates and spot what you're still looking

for.

You can **filter by media type and genre**, and **sort by title or artist**, making it fast and convenient to locate items in stores that sell physical media or if you're just searching for something in your own collection.


Whether you're a collector, enthusiast, or just staying organized — MediaFinder helps you keep your library in your pocket.



Add media by taking a picture of your shelf (MediaFinder Pro only) - With MediaFinder Pro you have access to this feature, unique to MediaFinder where after taking a photo of your shelf (or part of your shelf, better performance) you wait a few seconds and get a list of items found on that photo (more info in own section)

Add Media to wishlist or inventory - When you press this button, you get taken to another page where you can add any time of physical media you own, or want, to the app.

Enter search mode - When you press this button you will see filter buttons which you can use to filter through your media collection and wishlist, but you will also see the (un)filtered list of media.



Scan barcode button – The button you press when you don't want to deal with all of the items details manually, but rather can just scan the barcode on each item and get type, genre, title, and artist (if applicable) inputted in an instant. (MediaFinder Pro only)


Media type button – The media type button is a button with which you choose what's the type of media you're adding. It can be: Music, Movies, Tv, Games or Books. By clicking on the button you're taken to the next type.

Genre type button – For every media type you can choose from up to 10 genres usually based on the most common genres for the media type. Choosing is same as for the media type button, you reach the next genre when you press the button.


Owned/Wishlist button – By default all of media you add is owned media, if you press this button the status will be changed to wishlist. As with all other selections when you press it again it will be changed back to owned.

Title/Artist input – All media has title input and media like books and music also has artist input. In these fields you should enter their names.

Save button – When you press this button your media item gets saved and you can view it, delete it or set wishlist items to owned in the search mode.



In search mode you remove media by pressing the red x button and add media to collection when you press the cart button. The cart button is a sign that appears when you don't own a media item (when it's only on your wishlist).



Shelf scan flow – As already mentioned, with the MediaFinder Pro upgrade, you can use the shelf scanner. All you have to do is press the take photo button and position your phone in front of your shelf, we suggest you take more photos of smaller sections for better quality results. After you positioned your phone, press the shutter button, now you wait a few moments (on average 0.5s per item on the photo) and you will get a list of items captured with title, (artist), Media Type, and genre. You have the option to remove an item if an item which shouldn't have been caught was shown or if its already saved into your collection, and we do warn you about such items. If due to bad lightning, lower photo quality, etc. some items cannot be added to the list in the bottom we warn you about them.

In the end, scroll to the bottom and press the Add all to inventory button and success!
